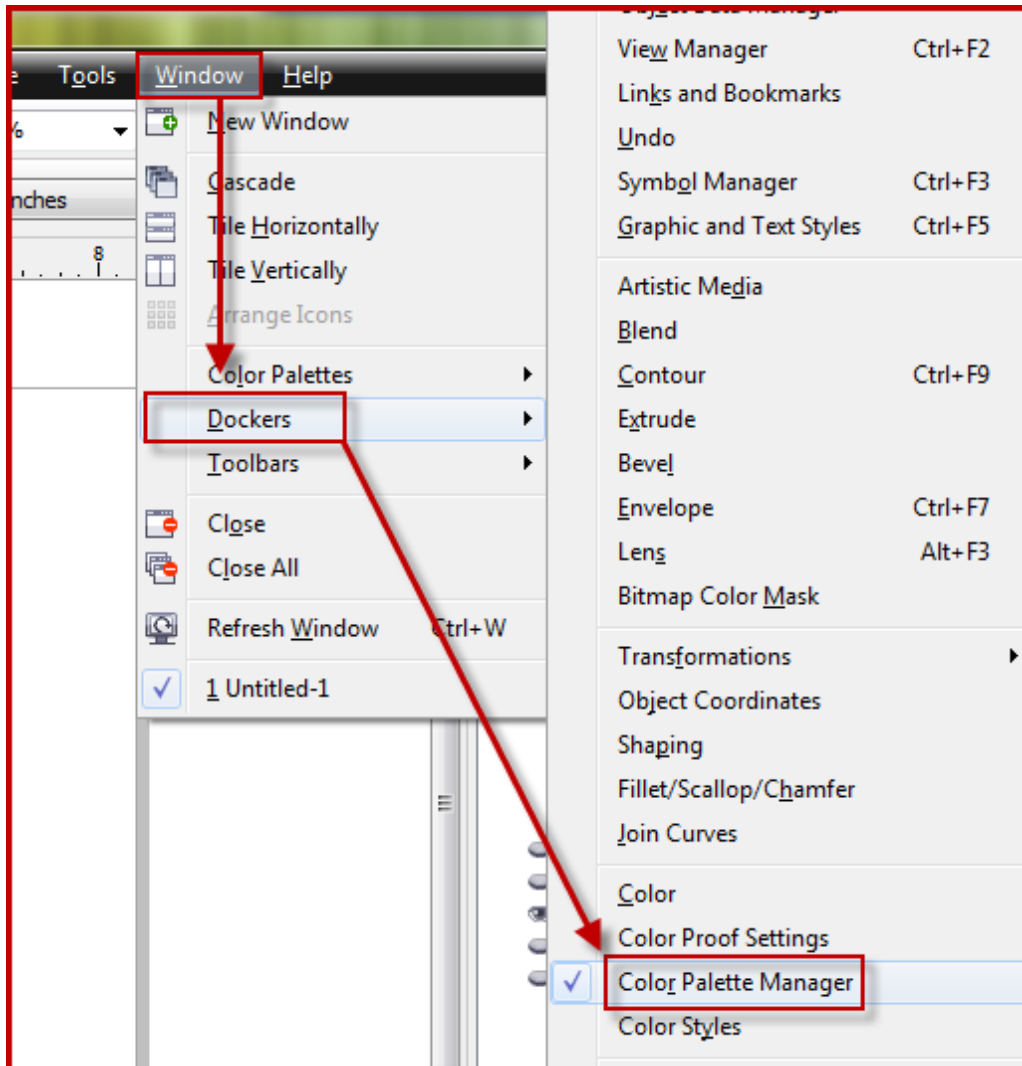


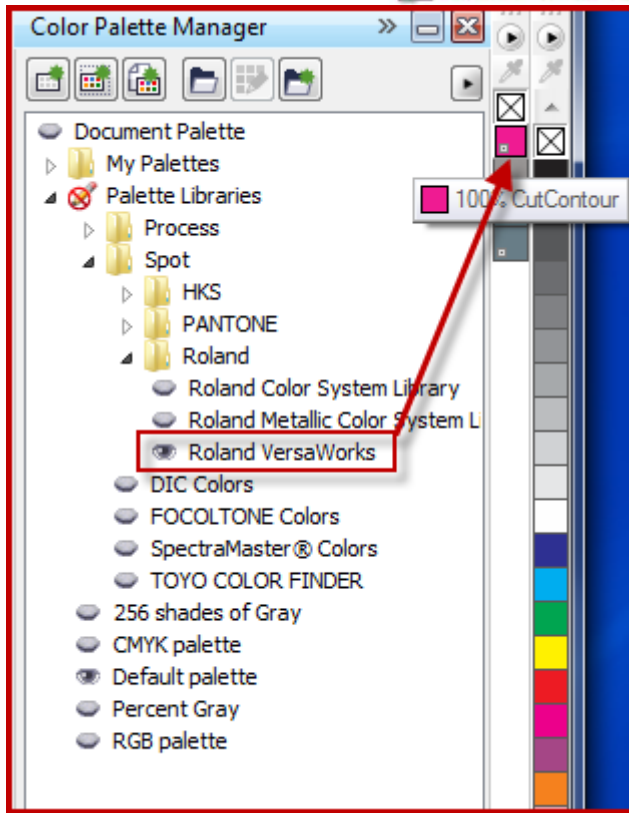
Using Roland Color Palettes in Corel X5 and X6

Open CorelDraw X5 or X6 and create a new document, click on "Window" in the menu bar at the top, then "Dockers > Color Palette Manager".



In the content window that opens (screenshot below), you'll find the Roland spot color library (which includes the CutContour color) under the following directories: "Document Palette > Palette Libraries > Spot > Roland". When you see the line item "Roland VersaWorks", just double-click on it to make it viewable. Now, you have access to the CutContour spot color to use within your illustrations.
